INTRODUCTION

Rural Electrification and Renewable Energy Corporation (REREC) Rural Electrification and Renewable Energy Corporation (REREC) a State Corporation enacted under section 43(1) of the Energy Act 2019 as the successor of REA with expanded mandate, as stipulated in the Act. Key programs to achieve the Mandate includes Grid extension, intensification, densification and deployment of Renewable Energy onsite and at utility scale among others as provided in Section 44 of the Energy Act.

3 ABOUT AGPO The legal requirement for women, youth and persons with disabilities to access 30% of Government Procurement opportunities is being implemented within the context of the Access to Government Procurement Opportunities (AGPO) program which was officially launched by H.E President Uhuru Kenyatta on 16th October, 2013 in Nairobi County.

The AGPO program is founded on the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 Article 227 on the fair, equitable, transparent and cost-effective public procurement of goods and services, Article 55 on affirmative action and, the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015.



The aim of the AGPO program is to facilitate the enterprises owned by women, youth and persons with disabilities to be able to participate in Government opportunities.

This is made possible through the implementation of the legal requirement that 30% of Government procurement opportunities be set aside specifically for enterprises owned by these groups. As a result, the program is aimed at empowering them by giving them more opportunities to do business with Government.



QUALIFICATION FOR PREFERENCE AND RESERVATIONS SCHEMES.

For the purpose of benefiting from preference and reservations schemes, an enterprise owned by youth, women or persons with disabilities shall be a legal entity that:-

- 1). is registered with the relevant government body;
- 2). and has at least seventy percent membership of youth, women or persons with disabilities and the leadership shall be one hundred percent youth, women and persons with disability, respectively.

- Business Registration Certificate/ Certificate of
- Incorporation.
- PIN/VAT Certificate.
- Tax Compliance Certificate.
- Partnership Deed for Partnership Business.
- Memorandum/Articles of Association and CR12 mandatory for Registered Companies.
- •For Construction Category Letter/Certificate from the National Construction Authority, Energy Regulatory Commission or any other Authorized Public Technical Body.



HOW TO JOIN ACCESS TO GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Step 1

Register a business enterprise at the Attorney General's Office in the form of a sole proprietorship business, partnership business or a limited company. The enterprise owned by youth, women or persons with disabilities shall be a legal entity that is registered with the relevant government body; and has at least seventy percent membership of youth, women or persons with disabilities and the leadership shall be one hundred percent youth, women and persons with disabilities, respectively.

Step 2

If business is a partnership, get a partnership deed from a lawyer, if it is a limited company, obtain a CR12 from the registrar of Companies (system generated soft copy).



Step 3

Acquire a PIN and tax compliance/ tax exemption certificate from the Kenya Revenue Authority website.

Step 4

Acquire all required certifications from professional bodies and authorities such as: National Construction Authority, Insurance Regulatory Authority, Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Kenya, Law Society of Kenya, National Council for Persons with Disabilities, National Environmental Management Authority, Energy Regulatory Commission of Kenya and all other authorized bodies.

Step 5

Open a bank account for the business and acquire a bank reference from the bank.

Step 6

Access the website www.agpo.go.ke and register online or visit your nearest Huduma Center for assistance.
